You may be eligible for greatly reduced local phone line installation and a credit each month to lower the cost of your local phone service.

The Link-Up and Lifeline programs provide these benefits to eligible individuals and families.

You're eligible for the Link-Up and Lifeline programs if you participate in any of the following programs:

To determine your eligibility for Link-Up and Lifeline and to enroll in these programs, call your local phone company.
